Dear Bob,

Thanks for your letter and SeaAgri, Inc. calendar. Great photos of some wonderful farm scenes! The peach trees for the November '07 picture look as if they could be down the street from me.

We had a great walnut harvest with more volume and better quality than ever before. The trees are nine, eight, and seven years old and, of course, still growing. The quality improvement could be accredited to sea solids. We did 550 pounds of salt per acre in the three tons of compost along with three foliar applications of one pound of salt per acre in with seaweed extract and fish emulsion.

I've enclosed a copy of the Department of Food and Agriculture inspection report of one of the loads of in shell walnuts that we delivered to the sheller this fall. These DFA reports are also known as "grade sheets"—it's like getting a grade in school. We had two loads that were "perfect" loads; they had zero defects and 100% light color with 47% edible yield! The man who owns the sheller later told me that our walnuts were the best quality of all twelve million pounds delivered this year. We are one of two organic growers delivering to his business this year. This also was his first year to certify for shelling organic walnuts. He and we were most pleased!

I'm sending you a box of 35% halves and pieces along with some labels so you can bag up some and give as samples or just use yourself. I'll be ordering two more truck loads of Sea-90 during February '07 to be shipped to Grover in Modesto and delivered to their Vernalis composting yard.

Looking forward to working with you during another excellent growing year.
